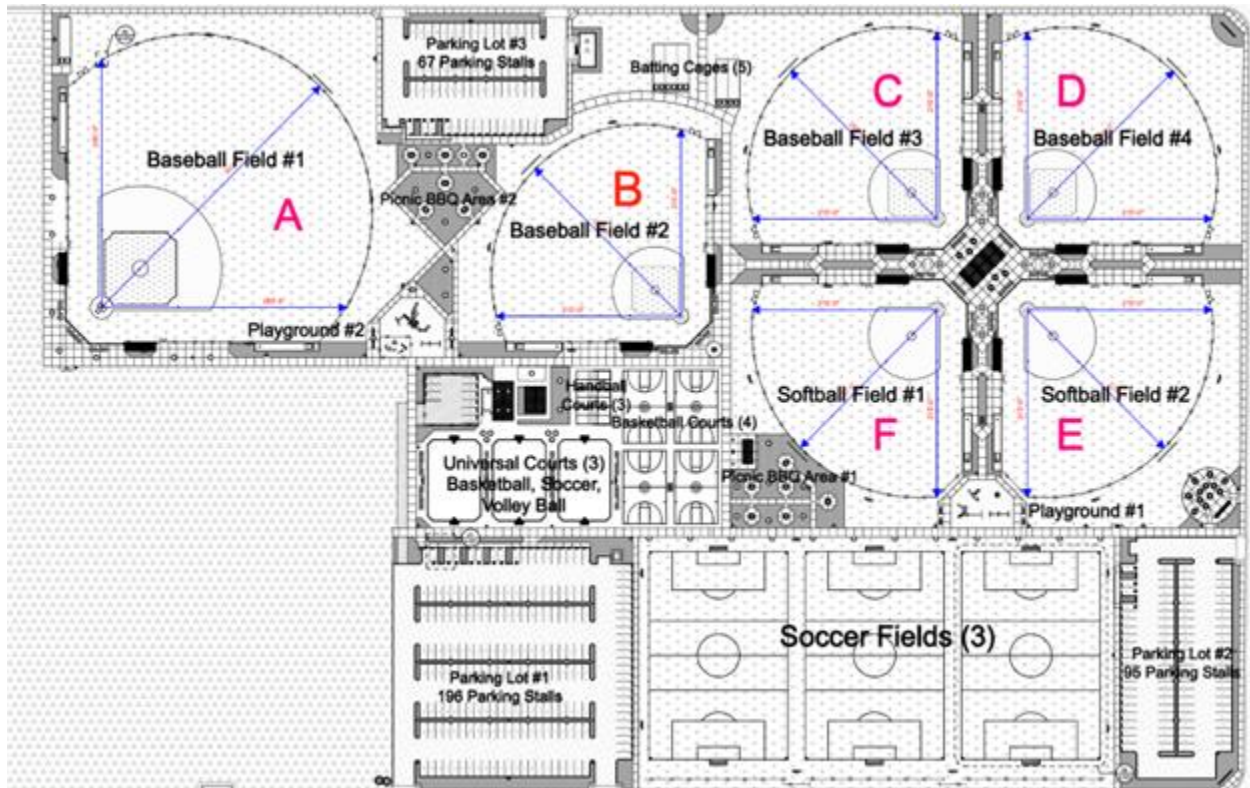

## Naming Rights Sponsorships

The mandate of the Shafter Recreation and Parks District is to enhance the lives of Shafter residents through providing safe, family-friendly, multi-functional, full-service recreational facilities for use in a wide range of events, meetings, entertainment, and recreation throughout all seasons, accessible to everyone in the community.

The Shafter community is growing and with the growth comes a much greater need to provide outdoor activities for all community members especially for youth, families and seniors. This is why the Shafter Recreation and Parks District (SRPD) is looking ahead. Community-minded, SRPD is partnering with The Wonderful Company to build a large complex beginning construction in early 2025. The plans have been drawn up and the land is just waiting for construction to begin, however, to make the complex all it should be, additional partnerships are needed.



The Wonderful Company Community Sports Complex will feature a whole host of amenities and attract visitors from all over California. The future 42-acre park will be a proud milestone for Shafter and Valley residents. There is an opportunity to create history by involving the community of businesses, youth, nonprofit organizations, residents, seniors and others to make a forever impression by contributing to this beautiful park.

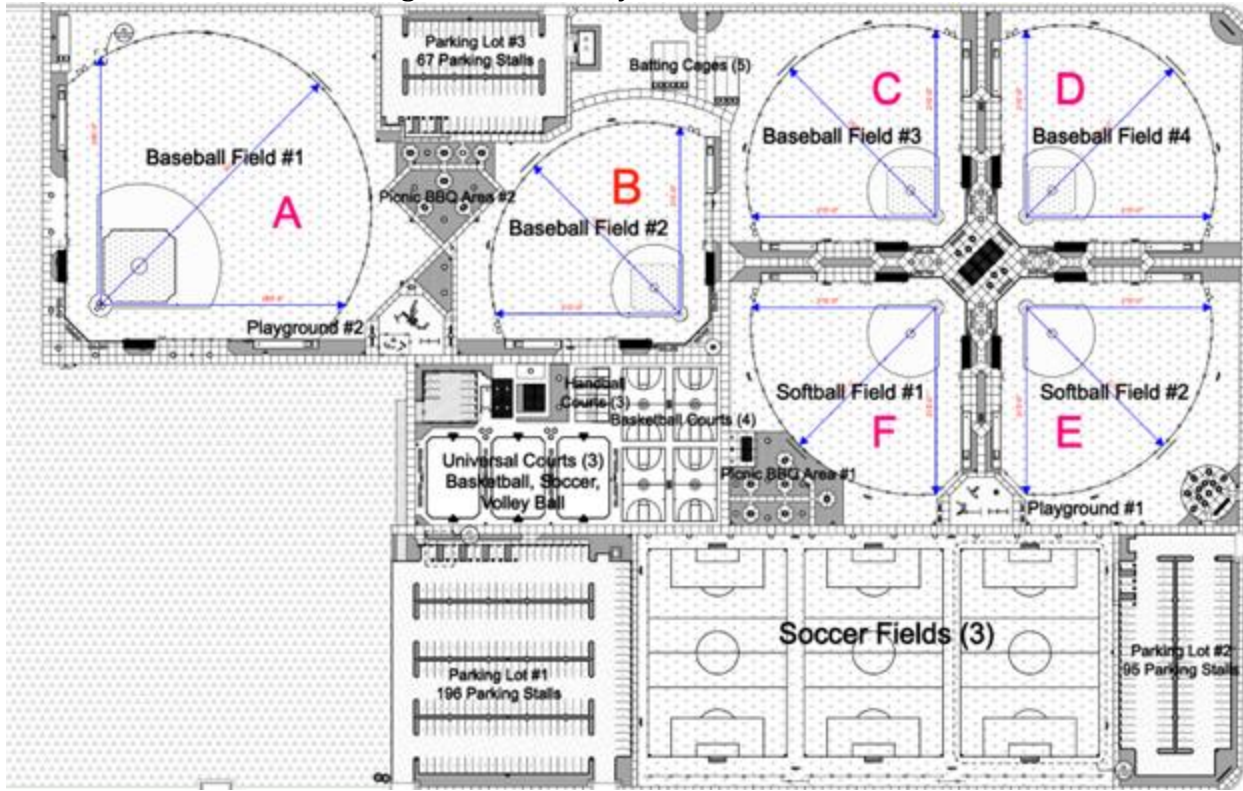
The featured park amenities for the first phase of development will include:

- 4 Basketball Courts
- 3 Soccer Fields
- 3 Handball Courts
- 2 Restrooms
- 4 Baseball Fields
- 2 Softball Fields
- 5 Baseball Battling Cages
- 1 Baseball Concessions Stand
- 3 Universal Courts
- 3 Parking Lots

The complex will be developed over four phases. The first phase will establish major recreational amenities that are currently lacking and help meet community needs. The design of the complex Phase 1 plan can be seen on the next page. There is a great need for recreational sports amenities. 2023 was a record breaker for the number of children and

youth who participated in SRPD sports. There were over 2,000 participants representing 176 teams for Basketball, Flag Football, Volleyball, Baseball & Softball, and Soccer.



The Shafter Recreation and Park District is reaching out to sponsors for each complex amenity. There are a variety of ways that individuals, businesses and others can contribute to the development of this beautiful complex.

This brochure highlights the variety of unique complex amenities and types of sponsorships available and demonstrates the breadth of opportunities that allow everyone to be involved. The sponsorship values are recommended based on the expected cost of each complex amenity. The complex will one of the most unique and largest parks in Kern County.

## Children & Youth Playgrounds Sponsorship

The City of Shafter has a rapid growing population of families. In 1990 the population was 9,616 residents and today it has more than doubled at 20,058. Also, the city has expanded its city limits, so more housing projects are being added as builders see prime opportunities within the Shafter City limits. Shafter borders the northern part of the City of Bakersfield and has become the fastest growing bedroom community due to the Gossamer Grove Lennar housing development.

The Shafter rural community is very family oriented. The Shafter Recreation and Parks District realizes that more community green spaces are needed to meet the growing

population. The answer is to create more recreational spaces available to children and youth. Most Shafter parks do not have playgrounds where families can gather to bond and enjoy a great outdoor park experience. Young mothers don't have sufficient places where they can take their toddler or preschooler to a safe place where they can enjoy relaxing in a beautiful outdoor park setting.

The Shafter Recreation and Park District will address this key issue by constructing two playground areas facilitating healthy play for children and youth. The Wonderful Company Community Sports Complex plan is to incorporate unique and attractive play structures targeting specific age groups within two separate playground areas. Each playground will reflect a castle theme and the pictures along with the full details can be seen on the next three pages.

# Park Playground Area #1

Suggested Playground Area Naming Sponsorship: \$100,000



Playground #1 will be located within the south section of the complex, close to parking and restroom. The playground is purposefully placed near the west picnic/BBQ area between the softball and soccer fields with access from two separated parking lots. This playground is meant to have a unique character to grab the attention of children from all age groups. One of the most striking features is the fenced play area for tiny tots (children 6 to 24 months). The tots play area has four imaginative play structures to accommodate up to 25 children.

The play structures include a playhouse, fun tunnel, small slide, and musical structure. The fun and colorful structures promote child physical and cognitive development.

The second outstanding playground structure is the Giant Castle tower for older children ages 5 to 12 years. The 28-foot one-of-a-kind giant castle will feature Rapunzel with her flowing hair cascading down from atop the painted tower castle window. The exciting play tower will have several easy access entrances, fun climbing wall, ladders to the top three sections, several staging lookout areas, and two slides top and mid-level to allow for fun exits from the castle. The ground floor of the castle will have seating area for children. Adjacent to this structure will be a swing set with two individual swings and one large oval swing for two.

The third major play feature will be a smaller castle for children ages 3 to 5 years. This castle will contain a fun slide, entry staircase, climbing pole, and side-stepping bars. The playground will be surrounded by seating with shade covering for parents and children.

The estimated complex Playground #1 cost is about \$649,000. This cost includes surrounding landscaping, playground foundation, four major play areas with structures, shaded spectator area, protective ground covering, design & install. The following sponsorships are available.

# Complex Playground Area #2

Suggested Playground Area Naming Sponsorship: \$75,000



Playground #2 will be located within the northwest section of the complex just below the north Picnic/BBQ area #2 between the east baseball fields. This playground is meant to serve children 3 to 5 years and 5 to 12 years. One of the most striking features is the castle motif with a connecting zipline.

The playground structures will include a castle, fun boat, swing set, and spinning wheel play equipment. The fun structures help to promote children's physical exercise through play.

The estimated cost for Playground #2 is about \$350,000. This cost includes surrounding landscaping, playground foundation, four major pieces of playground equipment, spectator area, protective playground surface area, design, and installation. # Universal Courts

Suggested Universal Courts Area Naming Sponsorship: \$150,000



The complex will have unique enclosed Multi Use Games Arenas (MUGAs) aka Universal Courts. There will be three Universal Courts can be configured into three different playing areas such as: Basketball/Soccer, Basketball/Soccer/Volleyball, and Basketball/Soccer for children, youth and adult play. The estimated costs for three Universal Courts are about \$1,300,000. This cost includes the cement pad, massive play area enclosure, texture color coating surface, plus surrounding seating, design, and installation. The three Universal Courts are located above Parking Lot #1 in the center of the complex. The types of design layouts along with pictures can be seen above and on the following page.

# Baseball/Softball Fields

Suggested Ball Fields Area Naming Sponsorship: \$250,000

The community of Shafter lacks a large baseball venue where baseball and softball games can be played in one central location. The Wonderful Company Community Sports Complex will help to meet this demand with six ball fields. The state-of-the-art ball fields will accommodate children and youth from 4 years to 14 years of age, as well as adult play.



The baseball and softball fields will not only serve the residents of Shafter but have a dual role. The six fields will help support the Shafter Recreation and Park District seasonal baseball/softball program. The fields will also be open to the public for use or reserved rental. Families will be able to play a friendly game of baseball.

In addition, the fields will help to host a variety of baseball **tournaments generating income** for local restaurants, grocery stores, fuel stations, and area businesses.



The baseball and softball fields will be a major attraction to the complex. The baseball/softball venues will bring thousands of spectators and hundreds of teams to the site. The complex will be teeming with baseball season excitement on weekends besides regular team practice use during the weekdays. Parents will get to enjoy the thrill of seeing their sons or daughters hit their first ball or make their first game catch. Spectators will be amused by the younger girls and boys playing in the 4-and-under divisions. Daughters will make dads proud as they bravely step up to bat and then race to reach first base. Mothers will beam as their child makes a great play and the crowd applauds.

The baseball and softball venues will help to bring families back to life. The Fall and Spring 2023 baseball and softball programs served 722 youth with 60 teams.

Children, youth, and families will be able to enjoy these great ball fields, featuring plenty of seating and shade with access to restrooms and the concessions stand, for many years to come.

# Baseball/Softball Fields

Suggested Ball Fields Area Naming Sponsorship: \$250,000

The estimated baseball and softball fields cost is \$4,100,000. This cost includes 6 ball fields with all above-ground grading, infield and outfield grass sod, fencing, dug-outs, lighting, field-irrigation piping, and electrical. Other added spectator amenities are listed below.

# Soccer Fields

Soccer is a very popular team sport in the Shafter Recreation and Park District. The Wonderful Company Community Sports Complex will add three high quality soccer playing fields. The cost of the three fields with lighting is estimated at \$1,600,000. These fields will serve the many children and youth, ages 3 and up, who play competitively in both day and evening hours. In addition, both the public and other youth and adult soccer leagues will have the opportunity to access these fields.

The Shafter Recreation & Park District runs a large Soccer League for boys and girls. In 2023, there were 35 soccer teams in the SRPD Soccer League with over 485 children and youth ages 4 to 14 years participating.



# Basketball Courts

Suggested Basketball Courts Area Naming Sponsorship: \$150,000

Basketball is a great way for youth to bond, get in shape, and build character. The sport is a favorite among families. 2023 saw 450 individuals participating representing 45 teams. The Wonderful Company Community Sports Complex will have four top notch outdoor basketball courts strategically located in the center of the park, next to Universal Courts, restroom, parking, and picnic area. The four courts are valued at \$480,000 and will attract many visitors to with the colorized cement court surface, lighting, and seating.

The Shafter Recreation and Park District is part of the Jr. NBA League, so participants wear competitive NBA team jerseys. It's a great look but more importantly children and youth learn how to prepare themselves to be better individuals and team players.

# Handball Courts

Suggested Handball Courts Area Naming Sponsorship: \$40,000

The Wonderful Company Community Sports Complex will contain three handball courts. The estimated cost is about \$300,000 for three cement courts with lighting. These are side by side outdoor courts that will be open ended. These are versatile courts which can be used for racquetball play. These courts will allow for three games to be played simultaneously without interference.

The courts can be used for children, youth and adults.

In addition, the complex will have two restrooms. Each restroom will be handicapped accessible equipped with a minimum 4 toilet stalls, and two handwashing sinks. The restrooms will be equipped with a baby changing station.

# Park Area Parking Lots

Suggested Parking Naming Area Sponsorship: \$15,000 to \$25,000

Parking will be readily available throughout the complex with 358 parking spaces planned for Phase I, representing 3 major parking lot areas. Each parking lot will be conveniently located for easy access to park amenities. Parking Lot #1 with 196 spaces located off of East Ash Avenue is the main parking lot for accessing the central park amenities such as basketball courts, soccer fields, south restroom, and south entry into the baseball field area. Parking Lot #2 with 95 parking spaces is located at the south corner of Golds Avenue and East Ash Avenue with easy access to soccer fields, south baseball fields, and the major south BBQ picnic area. Parking Lot #3 with 67 parking spaces off Alley Road will be located next to the northwest baseball fields, children and youth playground area, and will serve the north side of the park. Naming rights will be available for each of the three parking lot areas with sponsorship signs posted at each lot entry. The parking construction cost is \$819,000.

In addition, sponsorship is available for each parking stall. This will be a unique opportunity for individuals, families, and businesses to leave a lasting impression on park visitors with their sign design concept. There will be a creative opportunity to render a beautiful sign reflecting the Sponsored By "Sponsor's First & Last Name" (first line), dedication wording (second line), and a topper graphic logo. Sign examples are listed below.

# Park Signage Sponsor
